This leaflet holds important information in connection with your attachment to Department of Paediatrics and Adolescent Medicine during proton therapy.

Description of us

Ward 1 – Department of Paediatrics and Adolescent Medicine

Ward 1 is for children and adolescents admitted to hospital as inpatients. At Ward 1 we have children and adolescents with various diseases. Some of the patients are treated for a disease affecting their immune system to such an extent that it is almost disappears. The ward is thus "infection-free" and staff is very focused on hygiene, particularly hand hygiene in the kitchen and in the ward.

In case of fever, pain, nutritional issues or other problems, please contact the ward on weekdays between 16.00 and 08.00 and at all times during the weekends and on holidays.

Day unit – Department of Paediatrics and Adolescent Medicine

The Day unit is for children and adolescents who need to go to hospital for short-term treatment or an examination not requiring that they spend the night at hospital.

During radiation therapy, you will primarily be attached to the Day unit. The Day unit also has children and adolescents receiving outpatient treatment for various diseases. The Day unit is "infection-free".

At the Day unit, blood samples can be taken if the child/adolescent has a CVC/PICC-line/port, weekly weight controls and consultations with doctors or nurses about treatment-related side effects. Moreover, chemotherapy in connection with radiation therapy will most often be given in the day unit. You must meet at a specific time either before or after radiation therapy.

The Day unit is open Monday to Friday. Remember to bring the child's yellow health card. Scan the card when you arrive in the unit. In case of acute fever, pain, nutritional issues or other problems, please contact the unit on weekdays between 08.00 and 16.00.
